When the sun sinks behind the Waterberg, you'll retreat to our exclusive lodge—an oasis of comfort set within our 8000 ha (20 000-acre) privately owned reserve. Price List - effective from 1 January 2026

Not included in daily rates or packages:

- Road transportation to and from Johannesburg Airport @ US\$450 return per vehicle
- Advance application for firearm licenses.
- Hire of firearms @ \$ 20 a day + ammunition.
- Dipping, packing and freight cost of trophies.
- Tips, which are at the client's discretion.
- Insurance and medical cost.
- Meat of animals hunted.
- When a trophy is wounded and lost, 15% VAT (Value Added Tax) gets added to the trophy fee, as all non-exported trophies attracts 15% VAT.
- Specially requested imported food or drinks.
- *Non-hunting companion * activities available by prior arrangement. Rate for non-hunting companions, covers all cost associated with accompanying the hunter.
- Additional Game Drives, at \$80 per vehicle for morning or afternoon drive for non-hunters.

Included in Daily Rates:

- Accommodation in comfortable hunting lodge. Camp exclusivity is only guaranteed for a minimum total daily rate of \$1200, e.g. 3 guests at a time.
- Meals, refreshments, soft drinks, wines, bottled water and local wines, beer & liquor.
- Daily laundry, except on Sundays.
- Services of an experienced professional hunter, tracker, skinner and camp staff.
- Equipped 4x4 hunting vehicle.
- Field preparation of trophies.
- WiFi at Lodge

Deposit:

- \$300 per hunter & \$ 50 per non-hunting companion per day, to confirm the hunt.
- Balance of daily rate is payable 30 days prior to the start of the hunt.

Terms of Payment

- EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer), Wire Transfer or payment at Dinaka with Visa or Mastercard.
- Hunting days lost (e.g. through illness or rain) are payable at the full rate.
- In the event of a cancellation, the deposit will be forfeited. However if we can fully replace the hunt, the deposit less \$800 will be refunded.

Discounted hunts

Cull hunts on some species, at 30% - 50% of the listed trophy fee. Cull hunts will be at the discretion of the Professional Hunter.

Please note:

- Permit species as well as all birds require government permits. Permit application needs to be finalized at least 28 days prior to start of hunt. Permit fees vary between \$10 - \$310 per animal, and will be for the account of the hunter.
- All species listed are available and self sustained on this 20,000 acre privately owned game
- To ensure continuous quality we only hunt a limited number of trophies each year. We request that you indicate the species which you would like to hunt for when making your reservation, as the listing of an animal does not guarantee the availability.


